

Social Media: From Intelligence to Evidence

A 2 Day Hands-On Course for Investigators

Law Enforcement Officers who attend this class will learn how to proactively use social media and the Internet to gather intelligence, track suspects, identify gang members, conduct drug investigations and enhance all types of investigations.

The course instructs how to gather evidence displayed or hidden in social media and other sites, as well as investigating and preempting violence. Methods will be provided on how to protect the officer's real identity on social media; establishing a safe and thorough undercover persona through social media; conducting undercover investigations through the Internet and social media; and using these resources as a tool and an enhancement for a variety of law enforcement and investigative operations.

Attendees are encouraged to bring a mobile device for practical exercises. A laptop, notebook computer, or tablet is best – but recent model smart phones should also be sufficient.



This course is designed for patrol officers, detectives and investigative units, gang, narcotics, and vice investigators, intelligence and crime analysts, school resource officers, task force members and specialized enforcement units, supervisors overseeing investigative operations, and any sworn law enforcement personnel seeking to integrate social media and internet resources into casework, intelligence gathering, and officer safety practices.
